## Guide for Accomplishing the Progress Report Tables

### Objective of the Report:

To monitor the status and progress of priority projects in the GMS Regional Investment Framework (RIF) 2022 adopted by the 6<sup>th</sup> GMS Summit held in Ha Noi, Viet Nam on 30-31 March 2018.

### Key Contents of the Report (see following Report Tables):

#### TABLE A. PROJECTS IN RIF 2022 LIST

1. Report Table A is based on the tables of Investment and Technical Assistance Projects included in the Annex to the RIF 2022 circulated as a meeting document for the 6<sup>th</sup> GMS Summit (available at this link: <https://www.greatermekong.org/sites/default/files/Annex%20to%20Regional%20Investment%20Framework%202022.pdf>). Columns (1)–(4) of the Report Table have the same contents as those in the tables in said Annex to the RIF. However, column (3) (Description), please review the write up describing the project and indicate changes in the scope and other specifications of the project, if there have been any since the project was proposed for inclusion in RIF2022 [Note: The final list of projects for inclusion in RIF 2022 and their descriptions were as of September 2017 when the RIF 2022 was endorsed by the 22<sup>nd</sup> GMS Ministerial Conference (Ha Noi, Viet Nam, 19-20 September 2017)]
2. In Column (5) (Cost Estimate), the first sub-column shows the original estimate when the project was submitted for inclusion. Please indicate the new/updated cost estimate in the second sub-column, if there had been any change in the estimate.
3. In Column (6) (Potential Funding Source and Amount), the first sub-column likewise shows the original entries in RIF 2022. Please indicate any changes in the sources of funding and amounts, if any, since the project was originally submitted for inclusion in the RIF.
4. In Column (7) (Status Updates), which is the most important column in the Report Table, please provide updated information, as follows:
  - (i) For projects still at proposal stage, under preparation/development, or under financing proposal/negotiation, please indicate any advancement in status, including, as applicable:
    - Concept/Pre-FS completed, state date or month/year
    - FS completed, state date or month/year
    - Submitted for consideration by approving agency/authority, state date/month and name of authority/agency
    - Approval by approving agency/authority, state date/month and name of agency/authority

- Financing proposal submitted to a financing institution, state date/month and name of financing institution
  - Approval of financing, state date/month and name of financing institution
- (ii) For projects already under implementation, please indicate the progress accomplished as of reporting date, including, as applicable:
- Procurement process/bidding commenced, state date/month
  - Contract awarded, state date/month
  - Certain project components completed, state name of components
  - Estimated percentage of works accomplished, state percentage completion (if available)

Please provide any other pertinent updated information on the status of the project.

5. In Column (8) Key Locations and GMS Economic Corridor Alignment, please provide information on the project's location coverage and the GMS Economic Corridor that the project may be aligned with. For the key locations, multiple locations may be indicated. For the economic corridor alignment, please indicate: (a) North-South Economic Corridor (NSEC); (b) Southern Economic Corridor (SEC); or (3) East-West Economic Corridor (EWEC). You may refer for the updated alignment of these 3 main GMS Economic Corridor in the publication Review of Configuration of the Greater Mekong Subregion Economic Corridors in this weblink: <http://www.greatermekong.org/review-configuration-greater-mekong-subregion-economic-corridors>
6. In Column (9), please indicate the Expected/Planned Measurable Outputs of the project based on its Design and Monitoring Framework. These project outputs will be aggregated for results monitoring of RIF projects and the GMS Economic Program in general.
7. In Column (10), Project Contact, information should include the organization/institution as main proponents and/or implementing units of the project and contact/focal person. Contact details like email address, telephone number, and fax number of the person/organization are requested to be provided.

**TABLE B. PROPOSED NEW PROJECTS FOR INCLUSION IN RIF 2022**

1. Report Table B pertains to any new projects that the country would like to propose for inclusion in RIF 2022. This is in line with the premise that RIF 2022 is a “living pipeline” of projects and allows for the addition of new projects (or deletion of existing ones) based on changing priorities and conditions. As key guides for determining the eligibility of a new project for inclusion in RIF 2002 is its alignment with and/or support for the strategic thrusts/operational priorities stated in the Ha Noi Action Plan (HAP) 2018-2022 and/or the recently endorsed sector strategies and action plans. To provide help in filling up Table B, the list of Operational Priorities contained in HAP 2018-2022 have been attached to these Guide Notes as **Annex I**.

2. Columns (1) – (4) in Table B are the same as in Table A. However, although Columns (5) (Cost Estimate) and (6) (Potential Funding Source and Amount) are likewise the same as in Table A, no updates are required.
3. Column (7) (Justifications), which is intended to provide important information to help justify the inclusion of the project in RIF 2022, is divided into two sub-columns:
  - (a) Strategic thrust/ operational priority in HAP (listed in Annex I) and relevant sector priorities supported – Please indicate in this sub-column the specific relevant sector priority in the HAP and/or strategic thrust in the relevant sector strategy/action plan.
  - (b) Other justifications – Please indicate in this sub-column any other factor that you consider important in justifying the project's inclusion in RIF 2022.
4. Columns (8) – (10) are the same as in Table A.
